

International Naval Contest 2025

The International Naval Contest (INC) takes place every year on the 2nd December weekend with changing organizers. This year the Italian Navy Amateur Radio Club (ARMI) is responsible for the International Naval Contest 2025.

Date: December 13, 2025 16:00 UTC to December 14, 2025 15:59 UTC

Band: 10m - 15m - 20m - 40m - 80m

Preferred frequencies:

CW: 3,560 – 7,025 – 14,052 – 21,052 – 28,052 +/- MHz

SSB: 3,625 – 7,060 – 14,335 – 21,225 – 28,320 +/- MHz

Operating modes: CW - SSB - Mix

Report information:

1. Members: RST + CLUB + membership number (eg. "599 MA150")
2. Non-members: RST + serial number (eg. "599 001")

Points:

Naval Club Members 10 points, Non-members 1 point

The total score is the sum of the points multiplied by the multipliers.

Rules:

1. Each station can only be rated once per permitted band, regardless of the operating mode.
2. Each logged member of a Naval Club only counts once as a multiplier, even if station was worked on several bands.
3. NAVY-Participants may only participate with ONE Naval Club membership number.

Participant Categories:

A = Naval stations all band mixed mode (single op)

B = Naval stations all band CW (single op)

C = Naval stations all band SSB (single op)

D = All band SWL

E = Naval-Club station (multi op)

F = Non Naval Station

Trophies:

The 1st winner of each class.

EVERYONE receives a certificate of participation.

Logs:

All logs must be submitted using the official NAVAL LOGGER program via the "Send Log to E-Log" button. The file must include the station's call sign and participant class. If either of these attributes is missing, the log will not be counted. All logs must have the CBR (Cabrillo format) file extension, even if the contest was run using other software.
